

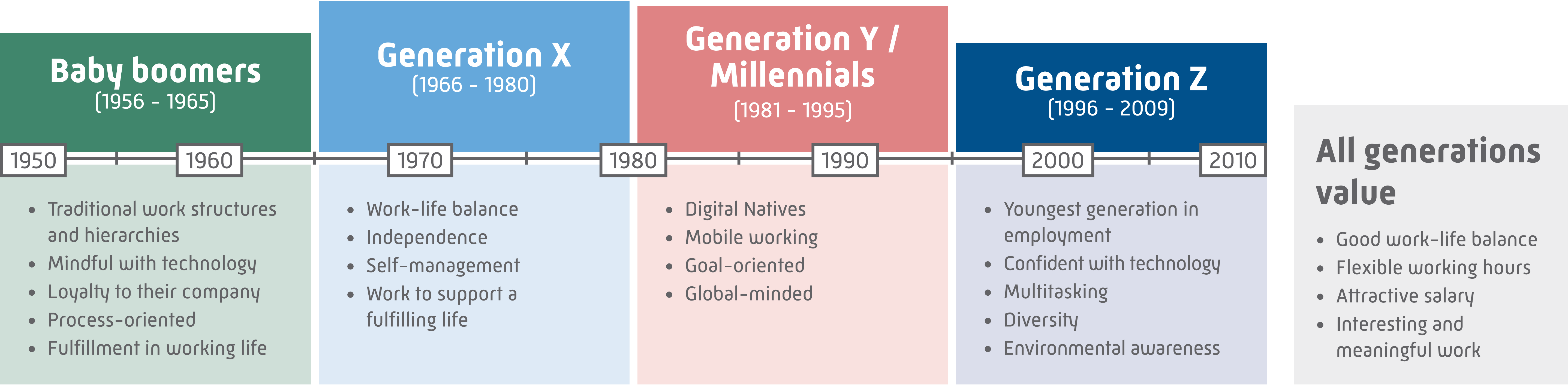
From Boomers to Gen Z: Bridging Gaps Between the Generations



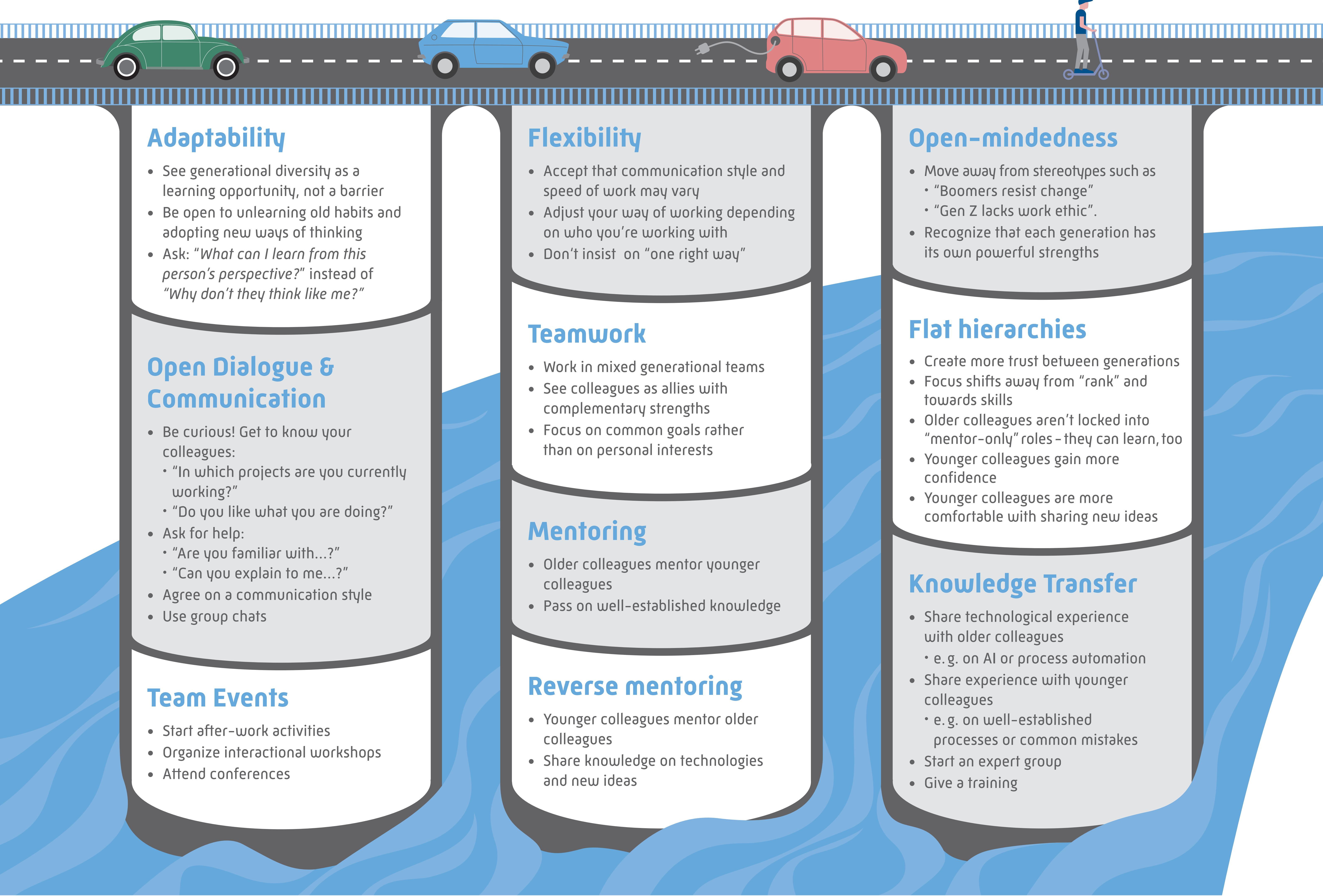
